## **ADVERTISEMENT**

This is to inform all concerned that fitment of GPS based Vehicle Tracking System and Panic Button in all Commercial vehicles (except two wheelers and three wheelers) has been made mandatory by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. This Department invites applications from interested, qualified manufacturers who have been approved by MoRTH for empanelment for the supply of Vehicle Location Tracking Systems with Panic Button in accordance with AIS-140 standard for all Public Transport Vehicles registered in the State of Nagaland since January 01, 2019. ## 1. General

- a) The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of INDIA (MoRTH) has mandated the fitment of vehicle tracker as per AIS 140 standards on New Commercial Passenger and Transport Vehicle with effect from 1st January 2019.
- b) As per CMVR 125H, Vehicle Location Tracking Device (VLTD) with Emergency Panic button needs to be installed in New Public Service Vehicles (PSV) from Jan 1, 2019. As per MORTH Guidelines (dated 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020 and S.O. 5453 (E).
- c) The regulation focused on Women Safety in commercial passenger vehicles such as buses and taxis.
- d) Safety of women and girl children is a prime concern during their travel in Commercial Passenger Vehicle [like cabs, taxis, public buses etc.] The proposed system envisages enhancing the safety of the women and the girl children by equipping all the public commercial passenger vehicles with location tracking device and emergency buttons for raising an alert in case of emergency.
- e) Motor Vehicle Department, Government of Nagaland proposes to implement a Backend Control Centre as per AIS-140 standards to track public transport vehicles in Nagaland. The objective of the project is to introduce a tracking system as required for implementation of central notifications for continuous monitoring of public transport vehicles for better road safety and better support for enforcement services.
- f) The Motor Vehicle Department Government of Nagaland intends to invite Indian manufacturers of VLT devices with valid AIS-140 certification by a CMVR Test agency and approved by MoRTH, for the supply and maintenance of the same devices to Public service vehicles registering in the state of Nagaland.
- g) As per MoRTH guidelines dated 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020, new public service vehicles shall not be registered in the State/UT if the vehicles are not equipped with or fitted with vehicle location tracking device and one or more emergency buttons, in compliance with the CMVR in the State of Nagaland.
- h) The specified public service vehicle owners have to ensure that the VLT devices installed in their vehicles, are in working condition and regularly send required data to the corresponding Monitoring Centre through cellular connectivity.

5	The manufacturer or its partner should provide repairing servicing and support in the state of Nagaland.	Self-declaration by the manufacturer and counter signed by the Partner (if applicable)
6	3 Year balance sheet and income tax return, and PAN and GST registration number of manufacturers.	Copy of relevant Certificate(s)
9	Type of approval from test agencies (ARAI /CIRT/ICAT /VRDE/ CFMTTI /IIP/GARC).	Copy of relevant Certificate(s)
10	COP or authorization from test agencies (ARAI /CIRT/ICAT /VRDE/ CFMTTI /IIP/GARC), as per AIS 140 (if applicable).	Copy of relevant Certificate(s)

### 3. Terms & Conditions:

- Only the authorized Firms who have been approved by MoRTH for empanelment for the supply of Vehicle Location Tracking Device with Panic Button in accordance with AIS-140 standard may apply.
  - The Dealership shall be given to the VLTS Centre, under the Motor Vehicles Department, Nagaland.
  - Interested firms must submit their application, SLA, device protocol and the required documents specified above through **Email: [commrtrans-ngl@nic.in](mailto:commrtrans-ngl@nic.in)**.  
*(Firms that have previously submitted their applications/documents/etc. need not resubmit)*
  - All interested firms have to pay a registration / application fee amounting to Rs.10,000.00 (Ten Thousand only) which is non-refundable through **online payment system/ NEFT/ DD in favor of Transport Commissioner, Motor Vehicle Department, Government of Nagaland**.  
*(Firms that have already made registration payments are exempt, provided their deposits have been accepted by the Department; otherwise, registration must be completed.)*
  - The firms are to submit to this office, a **Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) amount Rs. 5,00,000.00 (Rupees Five Lakh only)** with a validity of 18 months.
  - The firm will not be entertained if the PBG is not submitted. The performance bank guarantee should be through a Nationalized/Scheduled bank in the name of **Transport Commissioner, Motor Vehicle Department, Government of Nagaland**.
  - The Motor Vehicle Department reserves the right to reject any firm for incomplete submission of information without assigning any reason whatsoever.
  - Firms that have applied earlier need not resubmit their application, but are requested to submit their latest device model, if any.
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
